Registration:

- ➔ By appointment: Nov. 13 – Dec. 8, 2017
 - Students may register for intersession classes using their Spring 2018 registration appointment.
- ➔ Open Registration: Dec. 11 - 30
- ➔ Continuing and new students who apply by Nov. 2nd will receive a registration date and time via e-mail or mail.
 - New students who apply after Nov. 2nd will receive a registration date and time when they submit their application for admission to the college.
 - Returning students who attended the San Diego Community College District during the Spring 2017 semester, but did not attend Fall 2017, must activate a registration date and time on Reg-e at <http://studentweb.sdccd.edu/reg-e/> on or after October 16th to receive an enrollment date and time. *(Click on the Reg-e link under the Registration drop-down menu.)*
 - Students who have not attended one of the San Diego Community Colleges (City, Mesa, or Miramar) for two or more consecutive semesters must file a new application in the Admissions Office, or online at <https://www.sdccd.edu/future-students/admissions/index.aspx> to receive an enrollment date and time. *(Click on the Application for Admissions link.)*

Registration hours:

- Monday – Friday 7am to 12:00 midnight & Saturday 8:00am to 1:30pm
- **No registration** Nov. 10 & 11 and 23 – 25, 2017, Dec. 25, 2017, and Jan. 1 & 15, 2018
 - *During winter break, Reg-e will be available Dec. 21 – 30, 7:00am to 12:00 midnight; however, the college offices will be closed.*

- **Parking permits** will NOT be required to park in student lots during the 4-week Intersession (Jan. 2 – Jan. 27, 2018) *Note: Students may NOT park in Faculty/Staff lots or parking spaces.*
- **Class schedules** will be available online at: <http://schedule.sdccd.edu> on Oct 31st and on campus Nov. 8, 2017
- **Prerequisites** will be enforced during Spring Intersession.
- **Bus & Trolley passes:** Students attending Spring Intersession may purchase a monthly bus and trolley pass if they are enrolled in a minimum of 3 college units. The **monthly** bus and trolley passes are available for purchase at the San Diego City, Mesa and Miramar Accounting offices for a limited time (December 19 & 20 and January 2-10), while supplies last. Limit one monthly pass purchase per student, per month. The current monthly pass price is at a discounted rate of \$57.60. Published prices are subject to change by SANDAG (San Diego Association of Governments). **Semester** Bus & Trolley passes **are not** available during the Spring Intersession.
- A **Board of Governor's Fee Waiver** is available for eligible students.
